## **High School Connections**

## Adult High School Diploma and GED®

CCC offers alternative high school completion options for students who are at least 16 years old. High school aged students must be released or referred by their high school to participate. The college has an Adult High School Diploma program which provides students the opportunity to complete a high school diploma at CCC. The college also offers day and evening GED preparation classes in both English and Spanish. # Taking Classes at CCC While Still in High School

Students still in high school are welcome to take college courses at CCC! Students should follow the <u>Getting</u> <u>Started Steps</u> and do not need to go through a special process to take general classes at CCC unless they are under 16. Students under the age of 16 who wish to take a class must complete an "<u>Under 16 Enrollment</u> <u>Consent</u>" form to register for classes.
