Health Career Pathways

NURSING

Promote the health and healing of patients through assessment and clinical reasoning in the prevention and treatment of illness and injury.

PROGRAM DURATION: 2 academic years EARNING POTENTIAL: \$93,000-\$106,000 annually*

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY

Provide immediate care to critically ill/injured people on scene and provide transportation to care facilities. **PROGRAM DURATION:** 1 academic year (EMT Basic in 2 terms)

EARNING POTENTIAL: \$38,000-\$42,000 annually*

DENTAL ASSISTANT

Collaborate with dentists, hygienists and administrative staff to deliver high-quality oral health care and increase office efficiency. **PROGRAM DURATION:** 1 academic year **EARNING POTENTIAL: \$52,000-\$55,000 annually***

MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Work alongside physicians in medical offices and clinics to provide care and education to patients. **PROGRAM DURATION:** 1 academic year **EARNING POTENTIAL: \$46,000-\$51,000 annually***

NURSING ASSISTANT

Assist licensed nursing personnel to care for patients, providing client safety, infection control, mobility maintenance, nutrition and more. **PROGRAM DURATION:** 1 term **EARNING POTENTIAL:** \$36,000-\$43,000 annually*

Medical Billing and Coding

Looking for a career in health care but don't want to give injections or draw blood? Work with physicians and help patients in the front office with the Medical Billing and Coding certificate program. **PROGRAM DURATION:** 1 academic year **EARNING POTENTIAL:** \$46,000-\$48,000*
